**Final Ballot Title** The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the city's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

**Caption** 10 words which reasonably identifies the subject of the measure.

The measure amends the City Charter.

**Question** 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

To adjust the frequency of Council meetings; remove unnecessary and unconstitutional provisions; modify the process for issuing revenue bonds.

**Summary** 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

The purpose of the measure is to change the language of the City's Charter to do the following:

1. Allow for City Council meeting when business requires such meetings, rather than twice a month;
2. To remove language in the Charter concerning the consolidation with the City of Eastside, and the failed consolidation with the City of North Bend;
3. To remove section 9.11, which was ruled unconstitutional by the Court. The section required a certain number of policeman and fireman based upon the population of the City;
4. To remove the requirement that before revenue bonds can be issued by the City, that the issuance be approved by a majority vote of the electorate. Revenue bonds are paid back from a specific source of revenue, rather than from the general fund or a tax increase. An example would be paying for sewer improvements based upon revenue to the City's wastewater fund.
5. Adds "roadway" to the definition of Utilities in section 2.4.



 → any initiative or referendum, if required by local ordinance.


