

# Recyclable Items Accepted at Beaver Hill Transfer Site– Highway 101 541-396-7620

## Commingled Recycling – Please place in (2) Compactors marked Commingled in the Recycling Building

Please – NO plastic bags.

- Aluminum Cans      **Must be clean.** Remove all non-aluminum parts and rinse clean.
- Tin Cans            **Must be clean.** Do not flatten. Lids may be left on can. Paper may be left on can.
- Plastic Containers    **Must be clean.** #1 & #2 bottleneck plastic bottles, water & juice bottles, milk jugs, laundry jugs – Please remove lids.  
No need to remove label. Do not crush or flatten
- Recyclable Paper     Newspapers, Magazines & Office Paper - No other type of paper is accepted  
**Do not use string or rope to tie newspapers**

**Please Note: No plastic grocery bags, no frozen food boxes, no cereal boxes, no soda/beer cartons, no pet food bags, no TV dinner trays, no paper cups, no paper plates, no paper towels, no napkins, no tissue paper, no waxed paper, no tin foil, no paper ream wrappers, no diapers, no candy & snack wrappers, no Styrofoam, no beverage pouches, no egg cartons, no clear clamshell shaped containers, no clear lettuce tubs, no ice cream cartons, no shoe boxes, no box liners or packaging.**

- Corrugated Cardboard    Please place in the (2) large green containers for Cardboard in the Recycling Building  
PLEASE flatten boxes and remove any wrapping, staples or Styrofoam. No waxed cardboard.

- Motor Oil            The limit for used oil is 5 gallons per day.  
Oil must not be mixed with any other liquid or solvent.  
Oil recycling is self-service. You will pour the oil into a holding tank.  
A disposal bin is provided for your empty containers.

- Lead-Acid Batteries    Automobile, motorcycle, lawn equipment lead-acid batteries.

- Rechargeable Batteries Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-ion) ,  
Small Sealed Lead (Pb) weighting less than 2 lbs./1kg – Please leave with booth attendant.

- Cell Phones            All types – Please leave with booth attendant.

- Paint                    Products accepted in the Oregon Paint Care Program – Leave at Traffic Booth area.

- Electronic Waste      Limit is 7 items. Ask the Booth Attendant or visit [www.ecycleoregon.org](http://www.ecycleoregon.org)
