Measure Maintaining Police Services Through Public Safety Fee Increase

Shall North Bend increase the Public Safety Fee by \$5 to maintain current police services and prevent service reductions?

This measure seeks voter approval to increase the City's Public Safety Fee by \$5/month to provide increased funding for police services. This increase is being referred to the voters because of city charter and code provisions requiring voter approval to increase the public safety fee above \$15. The fee supports core public safety operations, including patrol staffing, emergency response, and overall service availability. The increase would also fund a police detective position, which is intended to improve the City's ability to investigate crimes, manage caseloads, and maintain timely follow-up on public safety concerns. Without the additional revenue, the City may be required to reduce police staffing or adjust service levels, which could affect emergency response times and the department's capacity to address ongoing and emerging public safety needs. A "yes" vote approves the fee increase, allowing the City to maintain existing police operations and add a detective to support investigative functions. A "no" vote rejects the increase, providing no new funding and potentially leading to reduced police staffing or service adjustments depending on available resources.
