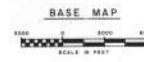

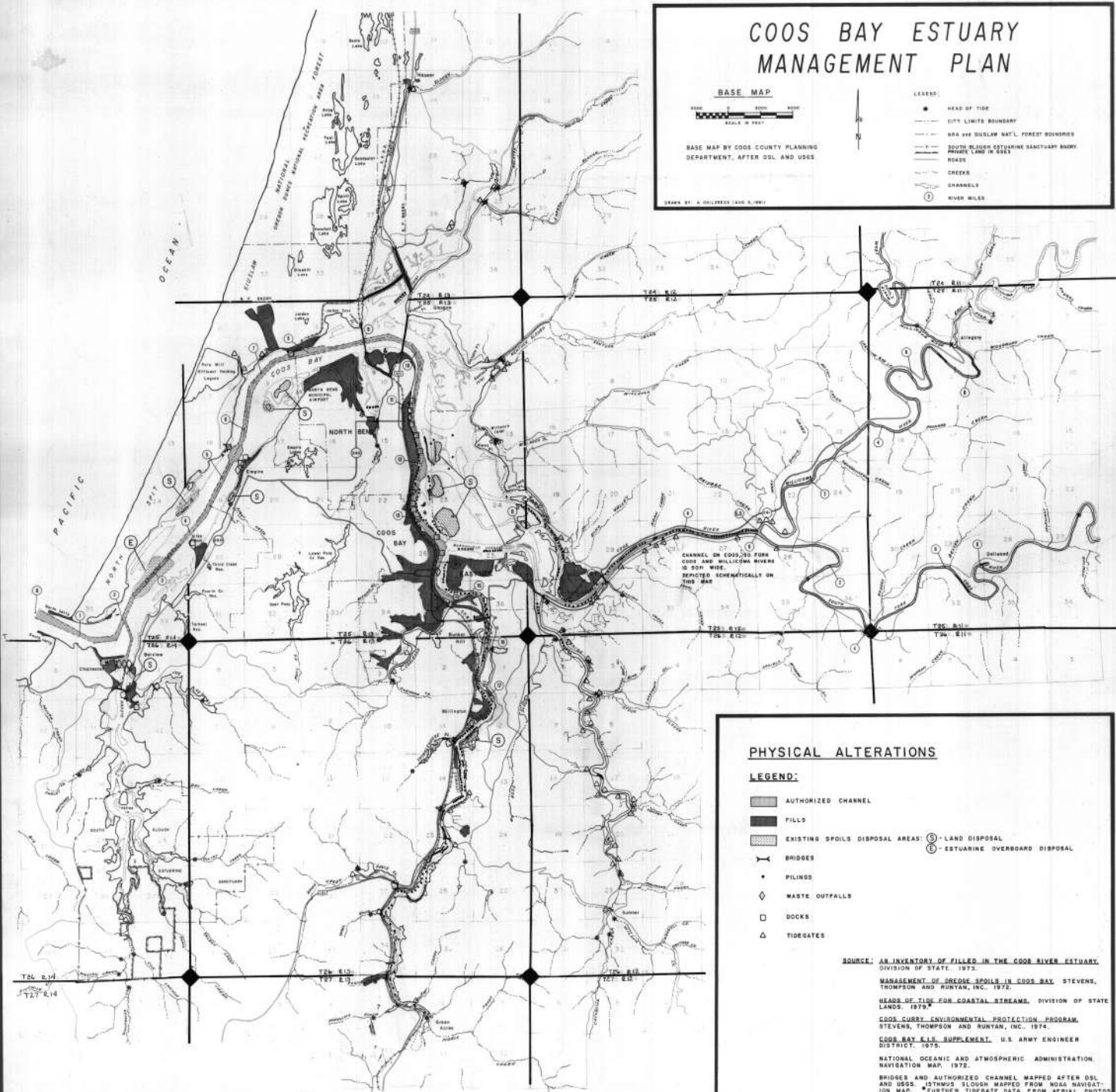


BASE MAP BY COOS COUNTY PLANNING
