Good afternoon,

Welcome to the November 4, 2025 Special Election for the Fairview Rural Fire Protection District and portions of Coos County.

Coos County Elections would like to take a moment to share some important dates and information regarding the upcoming Election.

- The last day to register, in order to qualify for this election, is October 14, 2025
- Ballots will be mailed to voters on October 15, 2025. If a voter, residing in the Fairview Rural Fire Protection District, or in the area proposed to be annexed to the district, does not receive their ballot by Thursday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, they should contact the Coos County Elections Office.
- A public demonstration of ballot programming and tabulation will be held on October 22, 2025 at 9:00am in the Coos County Elections Office
- The first report of election results will be available on the Coos County website at approximately 8:00pm on Election Day. A full schedule of when results will be released can be found on the Coos County website.
- Everyone interested are welcome to come observe the election process. Additional information, as well as the required forms for observation, can be found on the Coos County website.

This office would like to stress that ballots are not forwarded by the post office, so if a voter has moved or changed their mailing address, they need to update their registration. This may be done online at [www.oregonvotes.gov/myvote](http://www.oregonvotes.gov/myvote) or by completing a physical Voter Registration Card.

If mailing, ballots must be postmarked by the United States Postal Service no later than Election Day and be received in the office of the County Clerk no later than 7 days after Election Day. If utilizing an official drop-site location, ballots must be in the drop-box no later than 8:00pm on Election Day. The list of available drop-site locations is listed on the Coos County website and will also be printed on the ballot.
