Provide protection for the citizens of Coos County and the State of Oregon; Arrest and detain persons who have committed crimes; Enforce traffic laws; Investigate crimes and write reports; maintain security and control of jail; transport inmates; maintain security in the courts.

 6. **Essential functions of position:**
Strong will to provide a service to the citizens of Coos County and the State of Oregon
Must have ability to communicate effectively in English, both verbally and in writing
Enforces all Laws of the United States, Oregon, and Coos County
Operates a variety of motor vehicles and equipment
Use of physical force to control persons
Possible use of deadly physical force
Investigates crimes and complaints
Testifies in court proceedings
Maintains jail security, court security and all duties involved in the Police and Corrections field.
