NOTICE OF ELECTION REPORTING SCHEDULE

Election Date: May 19, 2026

Pursuant to OAR 165-007-0550(4), election results for the upcoming May 19, 2026 Primary Election will be posted to the Coos County website and the Oregon Secretary of State's website according to the following schedule:

- *Tuesday, May 19, 2026*
 - Election day results will be posted at 8pm with additional results posted approximately every two (2) hours until the final report for election night titled "Final Unofficial Election Day Totals Report."
 - **10pm report delayed. Next report will be the final report and is expected to be posted before 12am.**
- *Wednesday, May 20, 2026*
 - Unless prevented by voter turnout or other unanticipated factors, this report will include any ballots received election night that were not included on the Final Unofficial Election Day Totals Report. This report will be titled, "Post-Election Unofficial Totals Report."
 - **Report cancelled. All ballots processed on election night.**
- *Wednesday, May 27, 2026*
 - Tuesday the 26th is the final day ballots postmarked, no later than election day, can be accepted. This report will be titled "Final Unofficial Totals Report."
- *Final report, once election is certified, no later than June 15, 2026*
 - This report will be titled "Certified – Final Official Totals Report."

Please note, in the event any changes are made to the above schedule, or results are not posted by 6:00 pm on the date provided, a revised schedule will be posted on the Coos County website, along with an explanation for the change or delay in the reporting of election results. The "Final Unofficial Election Day Totals Report" and the "Post-Election Unofficial Totals Report" will contain an accurate tally of all ballots processed at the time of the report. Unanticipated factors, such as overwhelming voter turnout, could result in these reports not including all ballots received on election night.
