Notice of Right to Appeal:

- 1. The decision of the Hearings Officer can only be appealed to the Coos County Circuit Court by a Writ of Review as provided in Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 34;
- 2. A petition for a Writ of Review must be filed with the Coos County Circuit Court within 60 days of the date of the decision as contained in the written Judgment signed by the Hearings Officer;
- 3. The petition must be signed by the plaintiff and describe the decision or determination with convenient certainty, specifically setting forth the errors alleged to have been committed at the hearing.
- 4. Please understand that filing for a Writ of Review in the Coos County Circuit Court is technical legal work. You are urged to consider the use of an attorney to help you with your case.
