No Ballot Yet? Coos County Voters Should Contact County Elections Office

COQUILLE, OR — Coos County voters who have not yet received a ballot for the May 21st Primary should contact the County Elections Office for a replacement.

Over the past week, the Coos County Elections Office has heard from over 100 voters that they have not received their ballots, despite, in some cases, United States Postal Service (USPS) notifications indicating otherwise. USPS has not yet been able to determine the cause of the delay.

“While postal delays are not unheard of, at this point we advise any voter who has not yet received their ballot to contact us for a replacement,” said Coos County Clerk Julie Brecke. “There is still ample time for these ballots to arrive and for voters to fill them out and send them back before Election Day.”

“We appreciate voters flagging this concern for us and we are in regular contact with USPS to locate the cause of this delay,” said Brecke.

Voters can also visit the Coos County Elections office at the Coos County Courthouse (250 N. Baxter St., Coquille, OR 97423) to pick up a replacement ballot. Office hours are Mon-Fri from 8-5 (closed for lunch from 12-1pm). Election Day hours, on May 21, 2024, are from 7:00am-8:00pm.

“Any voter who wants to fill out their ballot sooner, rather than later, is always welcome to come to our office and request a new ballot,” Brecke said. “When we issue a new ballot to a voter, it receives a new barcode and the old one is automatically inactivated. You can be confident the new ballot will be counted and each voter will only be able to vote once.”

Election Day is Tuesday, May 21, 2024. Ballots must be received by 8 p.m. or postmarked on election day to be counted.
